Hebrews 6:5 - And have tasted the good word of God, and the **powers** of the **world** to come,

Job 6:30 - Is there iniquity in my **tongue**? cannot my taste **discern** perverse things?

John 8:52 - Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that thou hast a devil. Abraham is dead, and the **prophets**; and thou **sayest**, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death.

Mark 9:1 - And he <u>said</u> unto them, <u>Verily</u> I say unto you, That there be <u>some</u> of them that <u>stand</u> here, which shall not taste of death, till they have <u>seen</u> the <u>kingdom</u> of God come with power.

Psalms 119:103 - How sweet are thy <u>words</u> unto my taste! yea, <u>sweeter</u> than <u>honey</u> to my mouth!

Psalms 34:8 - O taste and see that the Lord is good: **blessed** is the man that **trusteth** in him.
