Tuesday October 6 2015: Commend

- 2 Corinthians 10:12 For we dare not make ourselves of the number, or compare ourselves with some that commend themselves: but they *measuring* themselves by themselves, and *comparing* themselves among themselves, are not wise.
- 2 Corinthians 10:18 For not he that *commendeth* himself is *approved*, but *whom* the Lord commendeth.
- 2 Corinthians 12:11 I am become a fool in glorying; ye have **<u>compelled</u>** me: for I ought to have been commended of you: for in nothing am I **<u>behind</u>** the very chiefest apostles, though I be nothing.
- 2 Corinthians 4:2 But have <u>renounced</u> the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by <u>manifestation</u> of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.
- Acts 14:23 And when they had <u>ordained</u> them <u>elders</u> in every church, and had <u>prayed</u> with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they believed.
- Acts 20:32 And now, <u>brethren</u>, I commend you to God, and to the <u>word</u> of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an <u>inheritance</u> among all them which are sanctified.

Ecclesiastes 8:15 - Then I commended mirth, **because** a man **hath** no better thing under the sun, than to eat, and to drink, and to be merry: for that shall abide with him of his **labour** the days of his life, which God giveth him under the sun.

Luke 16:8 - And the lord commended the <u>unjust</u> steward, because he had <u>done</u> wisely: for the children of this world are in their <u>generation</u> wiser than the children of <u>light</u>.

Proverbs 12:8 - A man shall be commended <u>according</u> to his <u>wisdom</u>: but he that is of a perverse heart shall be despised.
