## #24 - Release

Deuteronomy 15:1 - At the end of **every** seven **years** thou shalt **make** a **release**.

Deuteronomy 15:2 - And this is the <u>manner</u> of the release: Every <u>creditor</u> that <u>lendeth</u> ought unto his <u>neighbour</u> shall release it; he shall not exact it of his neighbour, or of his brother; because it is called the Lord's release.

Deuteronomy 15:9 - <u>Beware</u> that there be not a <u>thought</u> in thy wicked <u>heart</u>, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at <u>hand</u>; and thine <u>eye</u> be evil against thy poor brother, and thou <u>givest</u> him <u>nought</u>; and he cry unto the Lord against thee, and it be sin unto thee.

John 19:12 - And from <u>thenceforth</u> Pilate <u>sought</u> to release him: but the Jews <u>cried</u> out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's **friend**: whosoever maketh **himself** a king speaketh against Caesar.

Luke 23:25 - And he released unto them him that for <u>sedition</u> and <u>murder</u> was <u>cast</u> into <u>prison</u>, whom they had desired; but he <u>delivered</u> Jesus to their will.

Mark 15:15 - And so Pilate, willing to *content* the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged him, to be *crucified*.
