- 1 Timothy 6:17 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not <u>highminded</u>, nor trust in <u>uncertain</u> riches, but in the living God, who giveth us <u>richly</u> all things to enjoy;
- 2 Corinthians 1:9 But we had the <u>sentence</u> of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in **ourselves**, but in God which **raiseth** the dead:
- 2 Corinthians 3:4 And **such** trust **have** we through **Christ** to God-ward:
- 2 Kings 18:5 He trusted in the Lord God of Israel; so that after him was <u>none</u> like him <u>among</u> all the kings of Judah, nor any that were <u>before</u> him.
- 2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my rock; in him will I trust: he is my **shield**, and the horn of my **salvation**, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from **violence**.
- 2 Samuel 22:31 As for God, his way is *perfect*; the word of the Lord is tried: he is a *buckler* to all them that trust in him.
- Hebrews 2:13 And *again*, I will put my trust in him. And again, Behold I and the *children* which God hath given me.
- Proverbs 30:5 **Every** word of God is **pure**: he is a shield unto them that **put** their trust in him.
- Psalms 16:1 *Preserve* me, O God: for in *thee* do I put my *trust*.
- Psalms 40:3 And he hath put a new **song** in my **mouth**, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and **shall** trust in the Lord.
- Psalms 56:11 In God have I put my trust: I will not be <u>afraid</u> what <u>man</u> can do <u>unto</u> me.
- Psalms 71:5 For thou art my **hope**, O Lord God: thou art my trust from my **youth**.
