1 Corinthians 1:5 - That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge;

Acts 2:4 - And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other *tongues*, as the *Spirit* gave them utterance.

Colossians 4:3 - Withal <u>praying</u> also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the <u>mystery</u> of Christ, for which I am also in bonds:

Ecclesiastes 5:2 - Be not rash with thy <u>mouth</u>, and let not thine <u>heart</u> be hasty to utter any thing before God: for God is in heaven, and thou upon earth: therefore let thy words be few.

Isaiah 48:20 - Go ye forth of Babylon, flee ye from the Chaldeans, with a voice of singing <u>declare</u> ye, tell this, utter it even to the end of the earth; say ye, The Lord hath <u>redeemed</u> his servant Jacob.

Job 33:3 - My words shall be of the uprightness of my heart: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly.

Joshua 2:14 - And the men <u>answered</u> her, Our life for yours, if ye utter not this our business. And it shall be, when the Lord hath given us the land, that we will deal <u>kindly</u> and truly with thee.

Judges 5:12 - Awake, awake, Deborah: awake, awake, utter a song: arise, Barak, and lead thy captivity captive, thou son of Abinoam.

Psalms 106:2 - Who can utter the *mighty* acts of the Lord? who can shew forth all his *praise*?

Psalms 119:171 - My lips shall utter praise, when thou hast *taught* me thy *statutes*.

Psalms 145:7 - They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great goodness, and shall sing of thy righteousness.
