Gift

- 1 Peter 4:10 As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good <u>stewards</u> of the manifold grace of God.
- Hebrews 6:4 For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the <u>heavenly</u> gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,
- 2 Timothy 1:6 Wherefore I put thee in *remembrance* that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.
- Ephesians 2:8 For by *grace* are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
- 2 Corinthians 9:15 Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift.
- 1 Corinthians 13:2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not *charity*, I am nothing.
- 1 Corinthians 7:7 For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his **proper** gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that.
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is *eternal* life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Romans 5:18 Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto *justification* of life.
- Romans 1:11 For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some **spiritual** gift, to the end ye may be established;
- Acts 10:45 And they of the circumcision which believed were <u>astonished</u>, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost
- Acts 8:20 But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be <u>purchased</u> with money.
- Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the <u>remission</u> of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- John 4:10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have **asked** of him, and he would have given thee living water
