- 1 Peter 2:3 If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious.
- 2 Chronicles 30:9 For if ye turn again unto the Lord, your brethren and your children shall find <u>compassion</u> before them that lead them captive, so that they shall come again into this land: for the Lord your God is gracious and <u>merciful</u>, and will not turn away his face from you, if ye <u>return</u> unto him.
- 2 Kings 13:23 And the Lord was gracious unto them, and had compassion on them, and had <u>respect</u> unto them, because of his <u>covenant</u> with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not destroy them, neither cast he them from his presence as yet.

Ecclesiastes 10:12 - The words of a wise man's mouth are gracious; but the lips of a fool will swallow up himself.

Exodus 34:6 - And the Lord passed by before him, and proclaimed, The Lord, The Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in **goodness** and **truth**,

Genesis 33:11 - Take, I <u>pray</u> thee, my blessing that is brought to thee; because God hath dealt <u>graciously</u> with me, and because I have <u>enough</u>. And he urged him, and he took it.

Hosea 14:2 - Take with you words, and turn to the Lord: say unto him, Take away all <u>iniquity</u>, and <u>receive</u> us graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips.

Numbers 6:25 - The *Lord* make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee:

Proverbs 11:16 - A gracious woman retaineth honour: and strong men retain riches.

Psalms 103:8 - The Lord is merciful and gracious, **slow** to anger, and <u>plenteous</u> in mercy.
