- Ecclesiastes 4:13 Better is a **poor** and a wise child than an old and foolish king, who **will** no more be **admonished**.
- Ecclesiastes 4:6 Better is an handful with *quietness*, than *both* the hands full with travail and vexation of spirit.
- Ecclesiastes 7:5 It is better to **hear** the **rebuke** of the wise, than for a man to hear the song of fools.
- Ecclesiastes 7:8 Better is the **end** of a thing than the beginning thereof: and the **patient** in spirit is better than the proud in spirit.
