Sunday July 19, 2015: Oppression

Acts 10:38 - How God <u>anointed</u> Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy <u>Ghost</u> and with <u>power</u>: who went about doing good, and <u>healing</u> all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Deuteronomy 24:14 - Thou shalt not oppress an hired <u>servant</u> that is <u>poor</u> and needy, whether he be of thy <u>brethren</u>, or of thy strangers that are in thy land within thy gates:

Deuteronomy 26:7 - And when we cried unto the Lord God of our fathers, the Lord heard our **voice**, and **looked** on our affliction, and our **labour**, and our oppression:

Exodus 22:21 - Thou shalt *neither* vex a stranger, nor oppress him: for ye were *strangers* in the *land* of Egypt.

Ezekiel 46:18 - Moreover the prince shall not <u>take</u> of the people's <u>inheritance</u> by oppression, to thrust them out of their possession; but he shall give his **sons** inheritance out of his own possession: that my **people** be not scattered every man from his possession.


Job 36:15 - He *delivereth* the poor in his affliction, and *openeth* their *ears* in oppression.

Leviticus 25:17 - Ye shall not therefore oppress one <u>another</u>; but thou shalt <u>fear</u> thy God: for I am the <u>Lord</u> your God.

Psalms 12:5 - For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the <u>needy</u>, now will I <u>arise</u>, saith the Lord; I will set him in <u>safety</u> from him that puffeth at him.

Psalms 74:21 - O let not the oppressed *return* ashamed: let the poor and needy *praise* thy name.

Psalms 9:9 - The Lord <u>also</u> will be a <u>refuge</u> for the oppressed, a refuge in <u>times</u> of trouble.
