- 1 Corinthians 9:20 -And <u>unto</u> the Jews I became as a Jew, that I <u>might</u> gain the Jews; to them that are under the law, as under the law, that I might gain them that are *under* the law;
- 1 Timothy 6:5 -Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, **<u>supposing</u>** that gain is **godliness**: from such withdraw thyself.
- 1 Timothy 6:6 -But godliness with *contentment* is *great* gain.

Ezekiel 22:12 -In thee have they taken gifts to shed blood; thou hast taken <u>usury</u> and <u>increase</u>, and thou hast greedily gained of thy neighbours by extortion, and hast forgotten me, saith the Lord God.

Job 27:8 -For what is the **hope** of the hypocrite, though he hath gained, when God taketh away his **soul**?

Matthew 16:26 - For what is a man **profited**, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in **exchange** for his soul?

Micah 4:13 - <u>Arise</u> and thresh, O daughter of Zion: for I will make thine horn iron, and I will make thy hoofs brass: and thou shalt beat in <u>pieces</u> many <u>people</u>: and I will <u>consecrate</u> their gain unto the Lord, and their substance unto the Lord of the whole earth.

Philippians 1:21 -For to me to <u>live</u> is <u>Christ</u>, and to die is gain.

Philippians 3:7 -But what *things* were gain to me, those I *counted* loss for Christ.

Proverbs 1:19 -So are the ways of every one that is greedy of gain; which <u>taketh</u> away the life of the <u>owners</u> thereof.

Proverbs 15:27 -He that is greedy of gain troubleth his own **house**; but he that hateth **gifts** shall live.
