- 1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye <u>stedfast</u>, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the <u>Lord</u>, forasmuch as ye know that your <u>labour</u> is <u>not</u> in vain in the Lord.
- 2 Corinthians 9:8 And God is able to make all **grace** abound toward you; that ye, always having all **sufficiency** in all things, may **abound** to every **good** work:
- 2 Timothy 2:21 If a man therefore <u>purge</u> himself from these, he shall be a <u>vessel</u> unto <u>honour</u>, sanctified , and <u>meet</u> for the master's <u>use</u>, and <u>prepared</u> unto every good <u>work</u>.
- Colossians 1:10 That ye might walk <u>worthy</u> of the Lord unto all <u>pleasing</u>, being <u>fruitful</u> in every good work, and <u>increasing</u> in the <u>knowledge</u> of <u>God</u>;
