FAITHFUL

- 1 Corinthians 1:9 **God** is faithful, by **whom** ye were **called** unto the **fellowship** of his **Son** Jesus **Christ** our Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 10:13 There hath no <u>temptation</u> taken you but such as is <u>common</u> to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to <u>escape</u>, that ye may be <u>able</u> to <u>bear</u> it.
- 1 John 1:9 If we <u>confess</u> our sins, he is faithful and <u>just</u> to <u>forgive</u> us our sins, and to <u>cleanse</u> us from all unrighteousness.

Deuteronomy 7:9 - <u>Know</u> therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth <u>covenant</u> and <u>mercy</u> with them <u>that</u> love him and <u>keep</u> his <u>commandments</u> to a thousand <u>generations</u>;

Luke 16:10 - He that is faithful in that which is <u>least</u> is faithful <u>also</u> in <u>much</u>: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much.

Luke 16:12 - And if ye have not been faithful in that which is **another** man's, who shall give you that which is your **own**?

Matthew 24:45 - Who then is a faithful and <u>wise</u> servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his <u>household</u>, to give them meat in <u>due</u> season?

Matthew 25:21 - His lord said unto him, <u>Well</u> done, thou <u>good</u> and <u>faithful</u> servant: thou hast been faithful over a <u>few</u> things, I will make thee *ruler* over *many* things: *enter* thou into the *joy* of thy lord

Psalm 31:23 - O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD <u>preserveth</u> the faithful, and plentifully <u>rewardeth</u> the <u>proud</u> doer.
