Job 14:12 - So man lieth down, and <u>riseth</u> not: till the <u>heavens</u> be no more, they shall not awake, nor be <u>raised</u> out of their sleep.

Job 8:6 - If thou wert <u>pure</u> and <u>upright</u>, surely now he would awake for thee, and make the <u>habitation</u> of thy righteousness <u>prosperous</u>.

Judges 5:12 - Awake, awake, Deborah: awake, awake, <u>utter</u> a song: arise, Barak, and <u>lead</u> thy <u>captivity</u> captive, thou son of Abinoam.

Psalm 17:15 - As for me, I will behold thy <u>face</u> in <u>righteousness</u>: I shall be <u>satisfied</u>, when I awake, with thy likeness.

Psalm 35:23 - **Stir** up **thyself**, and awake to my **judgment**, even unto my **cause**, my God and my Lord.

Psalm 44:23 - Awake, why sleepest thou, O Lord? arise, *cast* us not off for *ever*.

Psalm 57:8 - Awake up, my glory; awake, *psaltery* and *harp*: I myself will awake *early*.

Psalm 59:4 - They <u>run</u> and <u>prepare</u> themselves without my fault: awake to <u>help</u> me, and behold.

Psalm 59:5 - Thou <u>therefore</u>, O LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel, awake to visit all the heathen: be not <u>merciful</u> to any wicked <u>transgressors</u>. Selah.

Psalm 7:6 - Arise, O LORD, in <u>thine</u> anger, <u>lift</u> up thyself <u>because</u> of the rage of mine enemies: and awake for me to the judgment that thou hast **commanded**.
