- 1 Corinthians 7:15 But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother or a <u>sister</u> is not under bondage in such cases: but God hath <u>called</u> us to peace.
- 2 Corinthians 13:1 Finally, <u>brethren</u>, farewell . Be <u>perfect</u>, be of good <u>comfort</u>, be of one <u>mind</u>, <u>live</u> in peace; and the God of **love** and peace shall be with you.
- Colossians 3:15 And let the peace of God rule in your <u>hearts</u>, to the which also ye are called in <u>one body</u>; and be ye <u>thankful</u>.
- Luke 2:14: **Glory** to God in the highest, and on **earth** peace, good will **toward** men.
- Philippians 4:7 And the <u>peace</u> of God, which <u>passeth</u> all <u>understanding</u>, shall <u>keep</u> your hearts and <u>minds</u> through <u>Christ</u> Jesus.
- Philippians 4:9 -Those things, which ye have both <u>learned</u>, and <u>received</u>, and <u>heard</u>, and <u>seen</u> in me, do : and the God of peace shall be with you.
- Romans 14:17 For the *kingdom* of God is not meat and drink; but *righteousness*, and peace, and *joy* in the Holy Ghost.
- Romans 15:13 Now the God of <u>hope</u> fill you with all joy and peace in <u>believing</u>, that ye may <u>abound</u> in hope, <u>through</u> the <u>power</u> of the Holy Ghost.
