Tuesday July 21, 2015: Proclaim

Exodus 33:19 - And he said, I will make all my **goodness** pass before thee, and I will proclaim the **name** of the Lord before thee; and will be **gracious** to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.

Isaiah 61:1 - The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath <u>anointed</u> me to preach good tidings unto the <u>meek</u>; he hath sent me to bind up the **brokenhearted**, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

Isaiah 61:2 - To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

Jeremiah 11:6 - Then the Lord said unto me, Proclaim all these words in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, saying, Hear ye the **words** of this **covenant**, and do them.

Jeremiah 34:15 - And ye were now <u>turned</u>, and had done right in my sight, in proclaiming liberty every man to his <u>neighbour</u>; and ye had made a covenant before me in the **house** which is called by my name:

Jeremiah 34:8 - This is the word that came unto Jeremiah from the **Lord**, after that the king Zedekiah had made a covenant with all the **people** which were at Jerusalem, to proclaim liberty unto them;

Jeremiah 7:2 - **Stand** in the **gate** of the Lord's **house**, and proclaim there this word, and say, Hear the word of the Lord, all ye of Judah, that **enter** in at these gates to **worship** the Lord.

Judges 7:3 - Now therefore go to, proclaim in the ears of the people, saying, <u>Whosoever</u> is fearful and <u>afraid</u>, let him <u>return</u> and depart early from mount Gilead. And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there <u>remained</u> ten thousand.

Luke 12:3 - Therefore <u>whatsoever</u> ye have <u>spoken</u> in darkness shall be <u>heard</u> in the light; and that which ye have spoken in the ear in <u>closets</u> shall be proclaimed upon the <u>housetops</u>.
