## Thursday November 5, 2015: Dine

1 Corinthians 11:24 - And when he had given **thanks**, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in **remembrance** of me.

Acts 27:35 - And when he had thus **spoken**, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in **presence** of them all: and when he had broken it, he began to eat.

John 21:12 - Jesus saith unto them, Come and <u>dine</u>. And none of the <u>disciples</u> durst ask him, Who art thou? **knowing** that it was the Lord.

John 21:15 - So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, *lovest* thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou *knowest* that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.

Luke 14:12 - Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a <u>supper</u>, call not thy friends, nor thy <u>brethren</u>, neither thy <u>kinsmen</u>, nor thy rich <u>neighbours</u>; lest they also bid thee again, and a <u>recompence</u> be made thee.

Matthew 22:4 - Again, he sent forth other <u>servants</u>, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have <u>prepared</u> my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are <u>ready</u>: come unto the <u>marriage</u>.

Proverbs 15:17 - **Better** is a **dinner** of herbs where love is, than a stalled ox and hatred **therewith**.
