- 1 Peter 1:7 NIV These have <u>come</u> so that your faith--of <u>greater</u> worth than gold, which <u>perishes</u> even though <u>refined</u> by <u>fire</u>--may be proved <u>genuine</u> and may <u>result</u> in <u>praise</u>, glory and <u>honor</u> when Jesus Christ is <u>revealed</u>.
- 1 Peter 3:4 NIV <u>Instead</u>, it should be that of your <u>inner</u> self, the <u>unfading</u> beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great <u>worth</u> in God's sight.
- Acts 20:24 NIV However, I <u>consider</u> my life worth nothing to me, if only I may finish the race and <u>complete</u> the <u>task</u> the Lord Jesus has given me--the task of <u>testifying</u> to the gospel of God's grace.
- Job 28:12-13 But where shall wisdom be found? and where is the place of <u>understanding</u>? Man <u>knoweth</u> not the price thereof; neither is it found in the *land* of the living.
- Lamentations 4:2 The precious **sons** of Zion, **comparable** to fine gold, how are they **esteemed** as **earthen** pitchers, the work of the hands of the potter!
- Luke 12:7 But even the very hairs of your head are all <u>numbered</u>. Fear not therefore: ye are of more <u>value</u> than many sparrows.
- Matthew 10:10 Nor scrip for your *journey*, neither two coats, *neither* shoes, nor yet staves: for the *workman* is worthy of his meat.
- Proverbs 10:20 The *tongue* of the just is as choice silver: the *heart* of the wicked is little worth.
- Romans 8:18 For I reckon that the **<u>sufferings</u>** of this present time are not worthy to be **<u>compared</u>** with the glory which shall be revealed in us.
