Monday April 6, 2015: Diligence

2 Peter 3:14 - Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye <u>look</u> for such things, be diligent that ye may be <u>found</u> of him in <u>peace</u>, without spot, and <u>blameless</u>.

Deuteronomy 4:9 - Only take heed to **thyself**, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine **eyes** have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: but **teach** them thy sons, and thy sons' sons;

Hebrews 11:6 - But without <u>faith</u> it is impossible to <u>please</u> him: for he that cometh to God must <u>believe</u> that he is , and that he is a <u>rewarder</u> of them that diligently <u>seek</u> him.

Joshua 22:5 - But take diligent <u>heed</u> to do the <u>commandment</u> and the law, which Moses the servant of the LORD charged you, to <u>love</u> the LORD your God, and to <u>walk</u> in all his <u>ways</u>, and to <u>keep</u> his commandments, and to <u>cleave</u> unto him, and to <u>serve</u> him with all your <u>heart</u> and with all your <u>soul</u>.

Proverbs 10:4 - He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the *hand* of the diligent maketh *rich*.

Proverbs 12:24 - The hand of the diligent shall bear *rule*: but the slothful shall be under tribute.

Proverbs 21:5 - The *thoughts* of the diligent *tend* only to *plenteousness*; but of every one that is hasty only to want.

Proverbs 22:29 - Seest thou a man diligent in his **business**? he shall **stand** before **kings**; he shall not stand before mean men.
