## #21 - Purpose

Ecclesiastes 3:1 - To every thing there is a **season**, and a **time** to every purpose under the heaven:

Ecclesiastes 3:17 - I said in mine heart, <u>God</u> shall <u>judge</u> the <u>righteous</u> and the <u>wicked</u>: for there is a time there for every purpose and for every <u>work</u>.

Isaiah 1:11 - To what purpose is the <u>multitude</u> of your <u>sacrifices</u> unto me? <u>saith</u> the LORD: I am full of the burnt offerings of <u>rams</u>, and the fat of fed beasts; and I <u>delight</u> not in the blood of bullocks, or of lambs, or of he goats.

Isaiah 14:26 - This is the purpose that is purposed upon the whole <u>earth</u>: and this is the <u>hand</u> that is <u>stretched</u> out upon all the <u>nations</u>.

Matthew 26:8 - But when his disciples **saw** it, they had **indignation**, saying, To what purpose is this waste?

Proverbs 20:18 - Every purpose is **established** by **counsel**: and with good **advice** make war.

Romans 8:28 - And we **know** that all **things** work **together** for **good** to them that **love** God, to them **who** are the called according to his **purpose**.

Romans 9:11 - (For the <u>children</u> being not <u>yet</u> born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to **election** might **stand**, not of works, **but** of **him** that **calleth**;)

Romans 9:17 - For the <u>scripture</u> saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, <u>that</u> I might <u>shew</u> my power in thee, and that my <u>name</u> might be <u>declared</u> throughout all the earth.

Ruth 2:16 - And let fall also some of the *handfuls* of purpose for her, and leave them, that she may *glean* them, and rebuke her not.
