Luke 5:32 - I came *not* to call the righteous, *but* sinners to repentance.

Mark 2:17 - When Jesus heard it, he saith unto them, They that are <u>whole</u> have no <u>need</u> of the physician, but they that are sick: I <u>came</u> not to <u>call</u> the righteous, but <u>sinners</u> to <u>repentance</u>.

Matthew 10:41 - He that <u>receiveth</u> a <u>prophet</u> in the name of a prophet shall <u>receive</u> a prophet's <u>reward</u>; and he that receiveth a righteous man in the <u>name</u> of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward.

Matthew 13:17- For verily I say unto you, That <u>many</u> prophets and righteous men have <u>desired</u> to <u>see</u> those things which ye see, and have not seen them; and to <u>hear</u> those things which ye hear, and have not heard them.

Matthew 13:43 - Then shall the righteous **shine** forth as the sun in the **kingdom** of their **Father**. Who hath **ears** to hear, let him hear.

Matthew 25:46 - And these shall go <u>away</u> into <u>everlasting</u> punishment: but the <u>righteous</u> into life <u>eternal</u>.

Matthew 3:15 - And Jesus <u>answering</u> said unto him, <u>Suffer</u> it to be so now: for thus it <u>becometh</u> us to <u>fulfil</u> all righteousness. Then he suffered him.

Revelation 22:12 - And <u>behold</u>, I come <u>quickly</u>; and my reward is with me, to <u>give</u> every man <u>according</u> as his <u>work</u> shall be.
