Matthew 10:24 - The disciple is not above his master, nor the **servant** above his **lord**.

Matthew 10:42 - And whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these <u>little</u> ones a cup of cold <u>water</u> only in the <u>name</u> of a disciple, verily I say unto you, he shall in no wise <u>lose</u> his <u>reward</u>.
