- 1 Timothy 3:5 (For if a man **know** not how to rule his own **house**, how shall he take **care** of the **church** of God?)
- 1 Timothy 5:17 Let the elders that rule well be **<u>counted</u>** worthy of double honour, **<u>especially</u>** they who labour in the **<u>word</u>** and **<u>doctrine</u>**.

Colossians 3:15 - And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are **called** in one body; and be ye **thankful**.

Hebrews 13:17 - <u>Obey</u> them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they <u>watch</u> for your souls, as they that must give <u>account</u>, that they may do it with <u>joy</u>, and not with grief: for that is <u>unprofitable</u> for you.

Isaiah 63:19 - We are *thine*: thou never *barest* rule over them; they were not *called* by thy *name*.

Leviticus 25:43 - Thou shalt not rule over him with *rigour*; but shalt *fear* thy God.

Proverbs 12:24 - The **hand** of the **diligent** shall bear rule: but the slothful shall be under **tribute**.

Proverbs 17:2 - A <u>wise</u> servant shall have rule over a son that <u>causeth</u> shame, and shall have <u>part</u> of the <u>inheritance</u> among the <u>brethren</u>.

Proverbs 25:28 - He that hath no *rule* over his own spirit is like a *city* that is *broken* down, and *without* walls.

Proverbs 29:2 - When the <u>righteous</u> are in <u>authority</u>, the people rejoice: but when the wicked <u>beareth</u> rule, the people mourn.

Proverbs 8:16 - By me *princes* rule, and *nobles*, even all the judges of the *earth*.
