Thursday October 24, 2015: Season

2 Timothy 4:2 - <u>Preach</u> the word; be <u>instant</u> in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all <u>longsuffering</u> and doctrine.

Acts 1:7 - And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the **seasons**, which the **Father** hath put in his own power.

Deuteronomy 28:12 - The Lord shall open unto thee his good <u>treasure</u>, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of <u>thine</u> hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not <u>borrow</u>.

Ecclesiastes 3:1 - To every thing there is a season, and a time to every **purpose** under the **heaven**:

Ezekiel 34:26 - And I will make them and the places round about my hill a <u>blessing</u>; and I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be **showers** of blessing.

Galatians 6:9 - And let us not be weary in well **doing**: for in due season we shall **reap**, if we faint not.

Isaiah 50:4 - The Lord God hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he <u>wakeneth</u> morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the <u>learned</u>.

Leviticus 26:4 - Then I will give you rain in due season, and the land shall yield her <u>increase</u>, and the trees of the field shall yield their <u>fruit</u>.

Proverbs 15:23 - A man hath joy by the <u>answer</u> of his mouth: and a <u>word</u> spoken in due season, how good is it!

Psalms 1:3 - And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that <u>bringeth</u> forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and <u>whatsoever</u> he doeth shall prosper.

Psalms 104:19 - He **appointed** the moon for seasons: the sun knoweth his **going** down.
